SUBJECT: Report of TAAG Recommendation regarding Project No. **N-DRC2023-00015**

A request by Templeton Historical Museum Society for a Minor Use Permit to allow for construction of a detached 2,400 sf storage building to house six historic Templeton carriages. The project will result in the disturbance of approximately 2,400 square feet on a .21 acre parcel. The proposed project is within the commercial retail land use category and is located at 301 Main Street in the community of Templeton, approximately two miles south of the City of Paso Robles. The site is in the Salinas River Sub Area of the North County planning area.

TAAG voted unanimously (5-0) during a publicly noticed Special Board Meeting on June 1, 2023 to recommend approval of this project.

TAAG remains an interested party to this project and requests to be notified if there are significant revisions to the proposal or if a MND is published, so TAAG may revise previously approved recommendations after any documents are added.
