**1. CALL TO ORDER**

**3. AGENCY REPORTS AND UPDATES**

3.1. Sheriff's Office – No report

3.2. California Highway Patrol - Live report by Chandler Stewart presenting CHP activity in the Templeton and general SLO North County area for the period September 1– October 31, 2021. Crashes were up: 58 in Templeton, 17 of which were on Highway 101. Others were on surface streets. There were no fatalities. There were 107 contacts, compared to 115 during this time last year. 32 were speeding violations, compared to 35 last year. DUIs were up over last year. There were 11 in the Templeton area.

3.3. Supervisorial District One - Supervisor John Peschong reviewed the multiple redistricting maps that will be discussed tomorrow at the Board of Supervisors meeting that will last many hours. It begins at 9 AM. There is another meeting on December 15 to review redistricting maps again.

3.4. Supervisorial District Five - Kathleen Gobel was present but could not get her audio to work in order to give her report.

3.5. County Planning Department - Cheryl Ku – The January 2022 meeting of the Planning Department will address the budget.

3.6. Templeton Community Services District – Geoff English

There was an audit report at last week's meeting. Senate Bill 1383 regarding organic waste haulers needing to monitor what is thrown out. This passed unanimously. It will probably mean rate increases for customers.

**5. CONSENT AGENDA**

**7. NEW BUSINESS**

**7.1 Update on Human Bean Lighting Code Compliance—**

Greg O'Sullivan, Templeton community member, reported on concerns about exterior lighting of the Human Bean building in Templeton. He has made requests to Code Enforcement to review what appears to be non-compliance with the Templeton Community Standards 22.104.090. It is our understanding that Code Enforcement is still reviewing this issue. TAAG Board unanimously voted to defer our recommendations till the December meeting after Code Enforcement has time to deal with this problem.

**7.2 Call for TAAG Board Candidates—**

In accordance with TAAG Bylaws, a call was made for candidates for the March 2022 annual election of TAAG Board members. Incumbents must declare their candidacy by the December meeting. Non-incumbents have until the January 2022 meeting to declare their candidacy. All candidates must be registered voters residing within the boundaries of the Templeton Unified School District.

**7.3 Presentation regarding proposed boundaries for new SLO County Supervisorial Districts—**

TAAG Board unanimously voted to recommend that Cal Poly be in the same district as the city of San Luis Obispo in order to maintain "communities of interest" and that the redistricting follow traditional redistricting principles that comply with the Fair Maps Act. Board Chair Bruce Jones agreed to present this recommendation at the Board of Supervisors meeting the following morning.
