Meeting on Thursday, August 13th was held by telecommunication / zoom video call

1.CALL TO ORDER - Meeting called to order at 5:35 p.m. by Chairperson Bruce Jones.

2.ROLL CALL - The following delegates were present: Bruce Jones, Murray Powell, Erik Gorham, Joe Jarboe, Kristen Gemeny, and Don Potts.

3. AGENCY REPORTS AND UPDATES

- **Sheriff's Office** - The Sheriffs office informed us that in July 2020 in the Templeton area the police department received 492 calls for service. Out of 492 calls 50 reports were taken. 16 of those were incident reports, 3 were battery related reports 1 of which was domestic violence, 3 mental health related reports, 4 abuse related reports, 4 theft related reports, 2 drunk in public related reports and 1 court order violation.

- **California Highway Patrol** - The California Highway Patrol started their update by thanking everyone for the support and encouragement during these trying times.

CHP informed TAAG that they continue to see an increase of speeding violations due to empty roadways during the pandemic.

During 2020, 462 collisions were investigated by CHP in the North County area. Out of 462 collisions 284 of those were property damage only, 156 injuries, and 6 of those incidents resulted in fatal injuries. CHP also informed TAAG of the decrease in fatalities during traffic collisions. In 2020 out of the 462 collisions there were 9 fatalities, which differs from 2019's number of fatalities which was 16.

- **Supervisorial District One** - Not Present.

- **Supervisorial District Five** - In the last month San Luis Obispo has reported 2,324 positive COVID 19 cases, 336 recovered cases, 16 cases in the hospital, and 4 of the cases are in intensive care.

On August 18th the Board of Supervisors will be meeting to discuss many important topics such as the Phase 3 amendments for the cannabis ordinance. If you have any questions you can email the board clerk or any of our district supervisors.

- 7.1 Review SLO County’s proposed Title 22 Chapter 22.40 – Cannabis Activities ordinance amendments and consider approval of various TAAG recommendations to be submitted to the County Board of Supervisors for consideration at the Supervisors’ scheduled August 18, 2020 hearing. County Planning issued an edited “redlined” draft of all proposed amendments of cannabis ordinance Title 22 Chapter 22.40 for public review and comment.**
Details of this recommendation are outlined in the TAAG Chair’s August 2020 Report to County located on the TAAG website under Reports.
- 7.2 Review and approve TAAG’s Cannabis Project Review Committee proposed recommendations regarding proposed cannabis Land Use Permit application No. DRC2019-00183 scheduled to be heard during a County Minor Use Permit Planning Department approval hearing on August 21, 2020. This project is located at 4337 So. El Pomar Road in Templeton. The project consists of 3 acres of outdoor cannabis cultivation areas, 29,500 square feet of indoor cannabis cultivation areas, and the construction of a 40,000 square foot indoor cannabis cultivation facility and a 5,000 square foot cannabis processing building.**
Motion - Murray Powell motioned to postpone the review of this project till more information is received. The motion was passed unanimously.
